#### ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- Completed <u>online application</u>
- \$100 application fee (waived for all current Santa Clara students and alumni, as well as veterans and active-duty military)
- Four-year bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university
- GMAT/GRE scores or waiver
- Official transcripts for undergraduate degree(s) and any post-baccalaureate work\*
- · Current resume or CV
- Two letters of recommendation
- Three business essays—collected together in one document should be uploaded in the "Documents" tab of the Program Materials section (it will be labeled "Personal Statement" there)
- Applicants for whom English is a non-native language must demonstrate English proficiency by submitting TOEFL or IELTS test scores. This requirement will be waived for applicants who score above the 50th percentile on the GMAT or GRE verbal section
- The University's <u>COVID-19 vaccination policy</u> strongly recommends that all students be fully vaccinated against COVID-19.

Although preferred, professional work experience is not required for admission to the Online MSFA.
